## Professor Julia Ault

#### How did you decide to study history?

As a kid, I loved to read historical fiction and try to figure out "fact" from "fiction" in the novels I was reading. As I got older--in high school and college--I became more and more interested in how the past informed the present. A big turning point for

ME CAME AFTER COLLEGE WHEN I WAS TEACHING ENGLISH IN THE FORMER EAST GERMANY. MANY OF THE TEACHERS I WORKED WITH HAD BEGUN THEIR CAREERS UNDER THE COMMUNIST DICTATORSHIP, AND DURING BREAKS, THEY OFTEN RELATED STORIES ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCES. AFTER THAT YEAR, I WENT TO GRAD SCHOOL IN PART BECAUSE I FELT COMPELLED TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE SYSTEM IN WHICH MY TEACHING COLLEAGUES HAD BEEN RAISED, EDUCATED, AND EMPLOYED. I ALSO WANTED TO BETTER UNDERSTAND THE LEGACIES OF COMMUNISM AFTER ITS COLLAPSE.

#### WHAT IS YOUR PRIMARY AREA OF FOCUS?

My primary focus is modern European History, with an emphasis on Germany, the Cold War, and environmentalism. My secondary focus is Russian and Eastern European History.

#### What do you like to do in your free time?

I like to run, hike, garden, and generally spend time outside. I also enjoy playing soccer and chasing after my kid. I also enjoy just relaxing by watching TV or listening to podcasts.
